

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Read all instructions before assembling

- Read these instructions carefully and familiarise yourself with the procedure before assembling the structure.
- Choose a location sheltered from the wind - **IMPORTANT** - This structure only has a single peak and therefore exposure to wind will put too much pressure on the canopy peak causing damage to the fabric;
- Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly.
- Take all the fittings out of the packaging and separate them into groups.
- Check you have all component parts and familiarise yourself with each part before proceeding.
- Assemble with at least 4 people.
- Please keep children away when assembling and please keep children under direct supervision of an adult when using.
- Do not repack until completely dry.
- Do not leave out overnight or unattended.

FIRE PRECAUTIONS

- Do not place near lights, fireplaces, gas or electric heaters, candles, radiators, or any other sources of heat, fire or flammable liquids.
- We recommend caution and common sense when in use.
- Do not use naked flames in or around the structure. We recommend you do not smoke while inside the structure.
- Please keep all exits clear and unobstructed.
- This structure features a fabric cover that is not flame retardant.
- This structure can burn.

WARRANTY

- Canopies are intended for events and other arrangements and are as such only meant for short term temporary assembly and disassembly. Wimba warranty applies only to the normal use of the product, normal wear and tear excepted, in accordance with written use instructions or manual. The warranty does not apply to damage caused by accident, abuse, weather conditions, misuse, modification or incorrect dismantle, erection, packing and storage of the product.





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


- Spread the canopy face down;
- Peg down the sides;
- Have two people position themselves under the peak of the canopy then connect the centre poles with one person holding the centre pole upright;



- When the fabric is too tight, have the remaining two people adjust the outside pegs accordingly - **IMPORTANT** - Do not over stretch the fabric, you just want it tight enough so the sides have enough tension to keep straight, otherwise you will cause damage to the fabric;



- Make sure the centre pole is positioned directly at the centre of the canopy as this is the toughest fabric to support the pressure of the sides - **IMPORTANT** - Make sure at ALL times the centre pole is centred at the peak;



- Make sure the centre pole is aligned straight to provide maximum support then peg down the base of the center pole;
- Now you are ready to go!
