IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING

Read all instructions before assembling

- On receiving your structure, please carefully check you have all parts. Please do not wait until the day you intend to use the structure to then find you have missing or damaged parts. This will allow us time to provide you with any replacement components before use.
- Read these instructions carefully and familiarise yourself with the procedure before assembling the structure.
- Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly.
- Take all the fittings out of the packaging and separate them into groups.
- Check you have all parts and familiarise yourself with each part before proceeding.
- Assemble with at least 2 people.
- Please keep children away when assembling and please keep children under direct supervision of an adult when using.
- It is highly recommended to use gazebo weights and ratchet straps for anchoring support during use (can be provided).
- Do not repack until completely dry.
- The structure has black plastic caps within each socket to hold each pole firmly within the sockets. It might be the case that some sockets will not require such caps and therefore this can be removed to allow the joints to connect.
- We recommend you use a mallet to assist in attaching the joints. Do not use a normal hammer as this may damage the poles.
- Please make sure the roof is securely attached to the frame. We recommend using at least three beams across the top of the structure to then support a roof.

FIRE PRECAUTIONS

- Do not place near lights, fireplaces, gas or electric heaters, candles, radiators, or any other sources of heat, fire or flammable liquids.
- We recommend caution and common sense when in use.
- Please keep all exits clear and unobstructed.

CERTIFICATION

This Sukkah was inspected on 24th August 2021 by a Court of the Chief Rabbi on behalf of the London Beth Din. It has been certified as suitable for sale for the festival of Sukkos Tishreie and therefore meets all the Halachic requirements required for the construction of a kosher Sukkah (subject to kosher schach being placed over it).

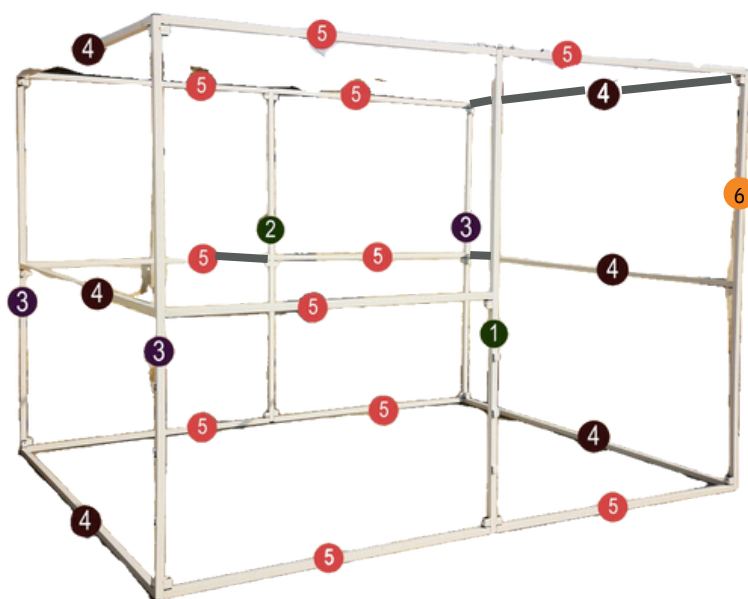
WARRANTY

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

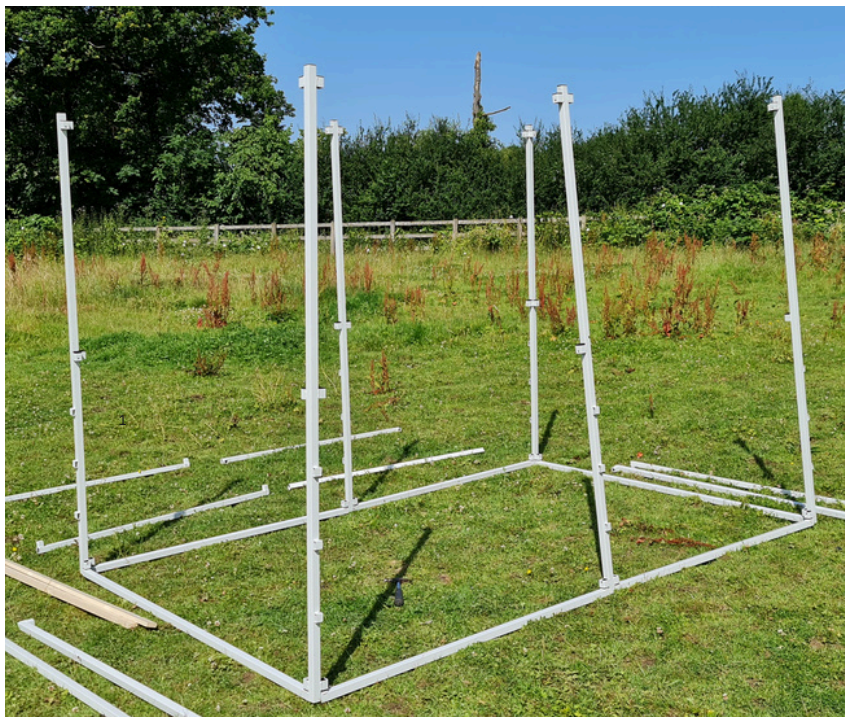
STEP 1

Lay all poles on the ground and organize them according to the illustration located on the content page.



STEP 2

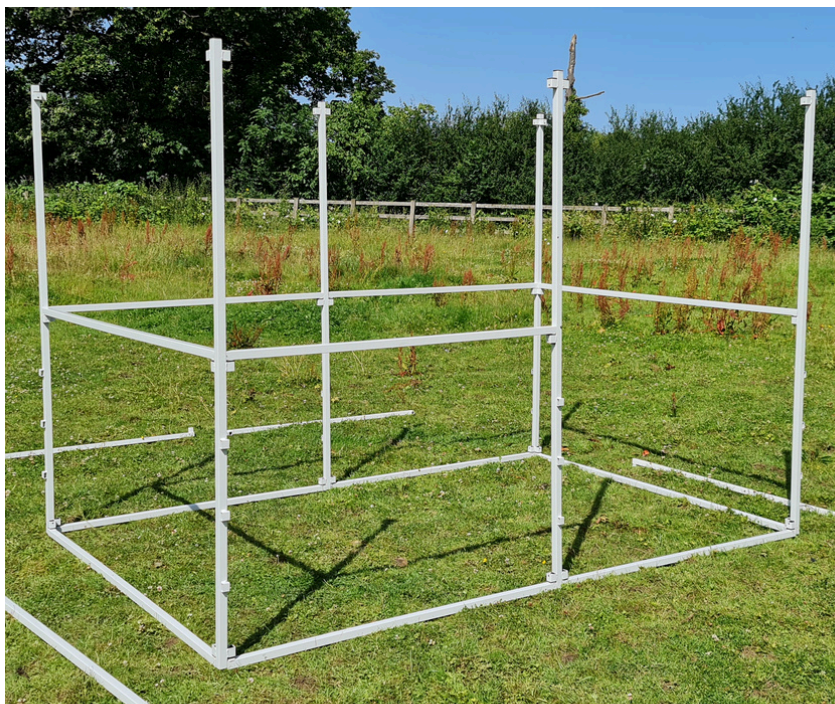
Attached all ground poles (poles 5) to the vertical poles (poles 1, 3 & 6). Make sure the three rings on each leg is located at the bottom facing outwards (this is for the straps latter).

STEP 3

Attached the middle horizontal poles (poles 4 & 5) to the vertical poles.



STEP 4

Attached the top horizontal poles (poles 4 & 5) to the vertical poles.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 5

Attach each of the three clips located at the end of the three straps into the holes located on pole 1 (left side of the entrance). Then thread the three straps through each of the three rings located at the bottom of each leg.



STEP 6

Attach the sides using the velcro located on the fabric. First start by aligning the zipped entrance then working around the Sukkah.
